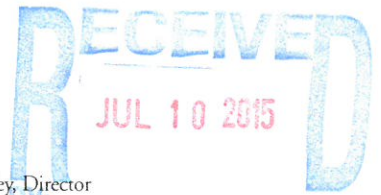

RE: Combined Sewer Overflow Long-Term Control Plan Changes

Dear Mr. Hoelscher:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources received the letter from your attorney, Ms. Susan Meyers, dated June 1, 2015, requesting approval of changes to the Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP), originally approved by letter dated June 1, 2011.

The department has completed its review of the non-material modifications of the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District's (MSD's) Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Long-Term Control Plan, February 2011. Per this letter, the department approves the modifications to the following LTCP measures as outlined in the June 1, 2015 letter (Attachments A and B) to the extent such modifications are consistent with the recent revisions to the federal Consent Decree, Case No. 4:07-cv-01120-CEJ:


- A. The CSO control measure and In-Sewer Storage Upstream of Lemay Outfall #063 is eliminated and the Lower and Middle River Des Peres Storage Tunnel will be increased by a corresponding 25 million gallons.
- B. The wording for CSO control measures for outfalls discharging to the Upper River Des Peres, River Des Peres tributaries, and Lower and Middle River Des Peres Storage Tunnels will be changed. The words “. . . to capture flows from Lemay CSO Outfalls [followed by a list of outfalls]” will be deleted to allow for alternate means to meet criteria in the Consent Decree.
