

ORDINANCE NO. 15104

AN ORDINANCE, appropriating Nine Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,800,000.00) from the Sanitary Replacement Fund to be used for sanitary sewer construction in FF-18 Villa Dorado – Lackland – Page Sanitary Relief (Adie Rd to Villa Dorado Dr) (10018) in the City of Maryland Heights, Missouri; and authorizing the Executive Director and Secretary-Treasurer on behalf of The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District to enter into Contract No. 21749 with Fred M. Luth & Sons, Inc. for the aforesaid sanitary sewer construction.

WHEREAS, the bid for said sanitary sewer construction is Nine Million Two Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$9,251,779.00) and the allowance for construction change orders and other project expenses is Five Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$548,221.00); and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that there is an unencumbered balance in the above-named fund sufficient to pay the obligation authorized herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE METROPOLITAN ST. LOUIS SEWER DISTRICT:

Section One. The sum of Nine Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,800,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Sanitary Replacement Fund for sanitary sewer construction in FF-18 Villa Dorado – Lackland – Page Sanitary Relief (Adie Rd to Villa Dorado Dr) (10018) in the City of Maryland Heights, Missouri; said contract being comprised of such terms and conditions as have been approved by the Office of the General Counsel of the District.

Section Two. The Executive Director and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District to enter into Contract

No. 21749 with Fred M. Luth & Sons, Inc., as the lowest responsible bidder for sanitary sewer construction in FF-18 Villa Dorado – Lackland – Page Sanitary Relief (Adie Rd to Villa Dorado Dr) (10018) in the City of Maryland Heights, Missouri, pursuant to bids received on the 20th day of December, 2018.

Section Three. This ordinance, being an appropriation ordinance, shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted on February 14, 2019.
